Subject: The Public Agenda report on teachers

"Today, going through the "Complete Survey Results" in the back of the book I noted Question 64: "How interested would you be in working at a charter school that was run and managed by teachers themselves?" This is a long ways short of what I'd hoped Public Agenda would ask the teachers-surveyed . . . and I don't see any indication that they ever did discuss this finding in the focus groups. The idea is also somewhat distorted by requiring the respondents to declare that they would like to work in 'a charter school' before even getting to the question of running the school. Whatever . . . the results are stunning:
